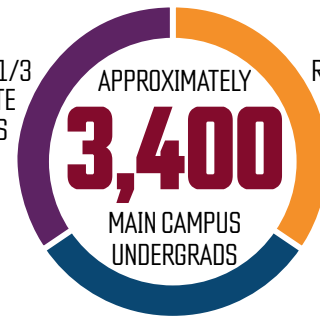

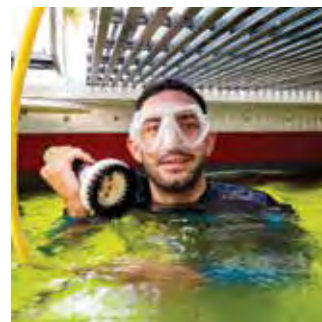
LEARNING ADVENTURES

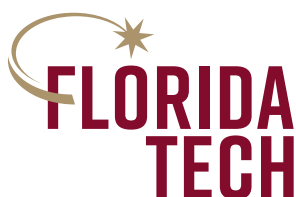
