At McDonald's, people are the face of our brand and critical to our success. Our ambition is to leverage our scale, training, and educations programs to build a path forward for people that supports their goals no matter where they are in life.

For those who choose to build their career with McDonald's, training, education, and leadership development programs can take them to the highest levels in our organization or with our Franchisees. For those kids who decide to move on, they will take with the valuable work-readiness skills like teamwork, interpersonal communication, and a strong work ethic to help them succeed in their next role.

McDonald's recently announced that the company will be investing \$150 million over five years to expand the Archways to Opportunity program and help employees advance their education pursuits. This investment triples the amount of tuition assistance available to our crew from \$700 to \$2,500 and managers from \$1,050 to \$3,000 and dramatically lowers the eligibility requirements. Previously employees had to work for nine months at a minimum of 20 hours per week to be eligible. Now they are eligible for tuition assistance after only 90 days of employment with a 15 hour per week minimum. That means you high school seniors can be eligible for tuition assistance before the start of the fall semester if they start in May.
