If you're an excellent student with an interest in languages, you have the opportunity to study abroad for FREE through a U.S. Department of State scholarship!

Over a dozen Scott County students have applied and been accepted to this selective program, studying for a summer or a school year in places like China, Korea, Russia, Indonesia India, Moldova, Tajikistan, and Germany to learn a language *at no personal cost*.

There are three options, all vetted for safety by the U.S. Government:
